



Safety guidance for using Google Classroom

It is imperative that all Google Classroom users remain safe. Please follow the guidance presented below to ensure your child/children is/are always protected. Please note, parents and carers have responsibility for what your children post. Please talk to your child(ren) about using Google Classroom responsibly. We have added some guidance for you to consider below:

Always log-in using your new Google account, which includes your name so all children can be identified.

Share work and photographs of material that you have been creating, which you are happy to be seen by others.

Avoid sharing photographs of yourselves or family members.

Try your best with your spelling, grammar and punctuation when writing on Google Classroom. We know how well you can all do in school!

For some children, a grown-up may need to help in accessing Google Classroom.

Log out of your Google Account (**not the classroom**) if you are sharing your device with a sibling.
